This program was taken over by Western Presbyterian Church in the 2016-2017 school year, as we discovered that it had been dropped by the volunteers at school. This has been an amazing project for our church as we serve those most needy in our school district. Currently, we are averaging 85 students this past 2020-2021 school year. We get our bags from FoodLink in Rochester and have 5 teams to get the boxes ready to go to the schools. This past year we have had Rotary members help with the delivery to the different buildings as our members age. This has been a great collaborative effort with the Pal-Mac School District. Even during COVID when schools were shut down our numbers increased to 200 bags per week to help any student. During COVID, the USDA provided lunches at no cost to us. Otherwise, between church mission money and generous donations from our community, businesses and grants we have been able to sustain this project.

Prior to Food Link providing the bags for delivery to the school WPC purchased the food.
